




Pie chart of the responses to the first question of patient survey.

2. Opill® is a birth control pill. Based on what you know about birth control pills, do you think Opill®... (select any choices you believe to be correct)




Bar graph of the responses to the second question of patient survey.



3. On a scale of 1-5, how safe do you think Opill® is?


Bar graph of the responses to the third question of patient survey. "1" indicates "extremely unsafe" and "5" indicates "extremely safe."


Bar graph of the responses to the fourth question of patient survey. This question was optional.


Pie chart of the responses to the fifth question of patient survey.




Pie chart of the responses to the sixth question of patient survey.

7. If so, would you be comfortable using your insurance to buy birth control pills?




Pie chart of the responses to the seventh question of patient survey.








Pie chart of the responses to the eleventh question of patient survey.
